
All horse movement papers should be submitted to the Secretaries Box. Any changes to draw, horse, or rider details should be submitted to the Secretaries Box.



Terms and Conditions

Program is ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws. more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee. The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft). Your ACA member-ship number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a com-plaint must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary within 1 (one) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$100 is forfeited. All prizemoney as per ACA Guidelines R9. Medical services provided by Qld Ambulance Services.
